## Decision automation provides these benefits:

- **Faster, safer, cheaper business processes:**

Automation of decision-making to replace human steps within business processes results in orders-of-magnitude improvement in process execution time, cost and reliability; plus side-effects of improved transparency, control, ease of deployment, and auditability of process execution.

- **Binding of business processes to business policy:**

Decisioning automates business policy within systems, providing strong, direct and verifiable linkage between operational processes and executive direction.

- **Faster, safer, cheaper systems development:**

Systems that are designed around decision models (being a proxy for business policy) are inherently simpler, better engineered, and aligned to the business, leading to 1-2 orders of magnitude improvement in systems development outcomes – safer, more cost effective, faster systems development.

- **Improved business agility over the life of the business:**

Decisions can be implemented as content within systems under the control of business owners – providing a 'remote control' to drive business applications on a day-to-day basis and increase business agility over the long term – specifically beyond the life of any component system.

- **New generation business models:**

Separation of decision making from process execution is the basis of new classes of process that cross organizational boundaries, creating new business collaboration models and extending the reach of automation across and beyond existing business domains.

All runtime components supplied with, or generated by, the licensed products can be used without constraint or cost on a world-wide basis, subject only to the requirement that the Licensee retains uninterrupted and exclusive ownership of the proprietary rights therein.
<b>IDIOM Decision Manager Features</b>	Decision model palette, formula palette, schema administration, in-palette testing, generated documentation (PDF format), model export/import (incl to/from other licenses), user registration and workgroup login, concurrent designer login, repository server, audit and change logging, Java/C# code generation, production release management, test and comparison tools, templates, <b>IDIOM Forms</b> and <b>IDIOM IQ Workbench</b> plugins.
<b>IDIOM IQ Workbench Features</b>	Component assembly, configuration, testing, and one click deployment of web services. Service activities may include business decision models; complex reflexive forms (including integrated forms control models); process control models; 'Word' document generation, controlled by 'Circumstance' decision models; and third-party controls. Additional features include management of user supplied (Word) document components, management of <b>IDIOM Forms Builder</b> artifacts, deployment to Microsoft and/or Open Source web servers.

The **IDIOM Decision Suite** is available in three editions based on the number of concurrent active designers required (all allow unlimited named designers):
